Junk Modeling

Can you make a bird out of boxes or clean cardboard from the recycling bin.

Collage pictures

Draw an outline of a bird on a piece of paper then using old magazines, cut out feathers and stick them onto the bird to make a collage.

Make a bird feeder

Repurpose used cardboard boxes, or plastic bottles. Carefully cut out a hole for the bird to access the seeds or bird food. Add a perch, a stick or straw for the bird to stand on.

Decorate the feeder then hang up with string. Bird seed is available from supermarkets and pet food shops.
